PAINTING NEWPORT CITY FOOTBRIDGE

Briefly describe what you want to do

A previous application was granted in 2024 to clean and repaint the Usk River Footbridge structure and concrete abutments using pressurised clean water. Then applying paint by roller or brush to the existing painted areas. Paint will not enter the watercourse. Unfortunately, due to poor weather and various delays only the cleaning was carried out.

The scheme now is to paint the structure using a MEWP and specialist rope access to the masts which span over the Usk River (Outside the line of the bridge deck) and to the outer sides of the bridge deck. The extent of the works is from the

east abutment (E331557 N188055) to the west abutment (E331421 N188001

But does not include painting of the bank seats or abutments.

Painting is confined to the masts of the bridge and the outriggers / cable supports at bridge deck level. Before painting can begin, a light washing of the surface will be required by pressure washing to remove any deposits which have settled on the structure since September 2024. Only clean water will be used.

Band 1 licences are typically issued for one year, subject to consultation.
