We have received your application to vary abstraction licence WA-366-0012-0007, however we are unable to accept it as valid. Please read the letter below which outlines what further information is required.

Hydrogeological Impact Assessment (HIA)

The report you have provided is required to be updated to assess the hydrogeological impact of the increased dewatering activity. The effects of increasing the dewatering volume and any proposed deepening should be considered in the HIA, and an updated water features survey identifying all potential receptors should be included. You should also consider if the updated volume is appropriate for future dewatering requirements as well as current quarrying activities.
