We need more information about your application

Thank you for your application received on 14/08/2024.

I need to ask you for some more information before I can do any more work on it. Please would you:

- Provide with more information on the amendments to following management plans:
 - Accident management plan – provide an outline of the changes/additions to the accident management plan including potential risks of accidents associated with the new 14" diameter pipeline (1,555 m) in the site. If this is not yet been finalised, provide a preliminary overview of the changes/additions to the accident management plan including potential risks of accidents associated with the changes.
 - Outline a summary of the parts of the Environment Management Systems that will be revised (either at the preliminary stage or final stage) as a results of using the pipeline and accepting waste slop oil and dewatering effluent.
 - Waste acceptance procedures (WAP) – section 3.2.2 States "Existing waste acceptance procedures will be revised". Can you provide either an outline what parts of the WAP will be revised and how these will take into account the acceptance of the dewatering effluent and slop oil from Valero Pembroke oil terminal, including procedures to handle the new wastes if they do not meet the criteria. You should outline how the WAP will comply with BAT 2 of the [waste treatment BRef](#) (This BAT conclusion is applicable as the waste is being added under a S5.3 A1 (a) activity).

- Provide with more information on the specification of both the new 14" diameter pipeline (1,555 m) either at (or the specification of the preliminary design(s)) and how this design will have containment to prevent contamination to land in the event that a leak occurs in this section of pipework.
- Provide information on how the treatment of process of waste from Valero Pembroke oil terminal will comply with the relevant/applicable BAT conclusions of the Waste treatment BRef.
