Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 Regulation 36 Notice

I am writing to formally withdraw the Regulation 36 notice that was served on the 23 August 2016.

This notice was served on you in respect of a non-compliance with a condition of your standard rules permit EPR/FP3097EZ.

On the 7 October 2016, we informed you in writing that the rule set for Standard Rules permit you operate under, SR2012 No14 Metal Recycling, Vehicle storage, depollution and dismantling (authorised treatment) facility, were being consulted on. You were advised not to undertake any expensive changes to infrastructure or to apply for a bespoke permit until the consultation process was complete and we knew what changes, if any, were going to be made to the Standard Rules set.

Following the consultation process, there were changes made to the drainage part of the Standard Rules set which allowed the storage of undamaged, un-depolluted vehicles on a drainage system that discharged to surface water or ground water. You were notified of the changes to the rule set.

It is the operator's responsibility to ensure you meet the requirements to the standard rule set.

Cont/d.

Following an inspection on 18 January 2019, it was noted that scrap metal was being stored on an area of impermeable surface that drains via an oil interceptor to groundwater.

This is a breach of condition 2.3.1 under point 6.- All other waste must be stored on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage system.

This breach was detailed in the compliance inspection report ref CAR_NRW0034498 dated 18/1/2019.

Please can you confirm by 12 April 2019, what steps you intend to take to bring your site into compliance with the conditions of your permit.

Please note that we will be serving another Regulation 36 Notice to comply with condition 2.3.1
