

Depollution Plan

- Put motorbike on the ramp & lock front wheel in chock.



- Put the bike onto a paddock stand / abba stand / centre stand depending on the bike.



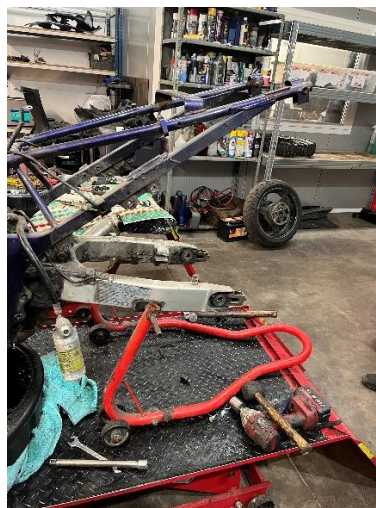
- Complete depollution record / check sheet.
- Remove the battery and place in the battery box.
- Drain the fuel from tank and carburettor / injectors & put in the green jerry cans.
- Drain fluids (engine oil, coolant, brake fluid & fork oil if needed draining) and put in the designated waste storage drums.
- Remove seats & tank.
- Remove indicators, plastics, fairings, lights & tachometer and label.



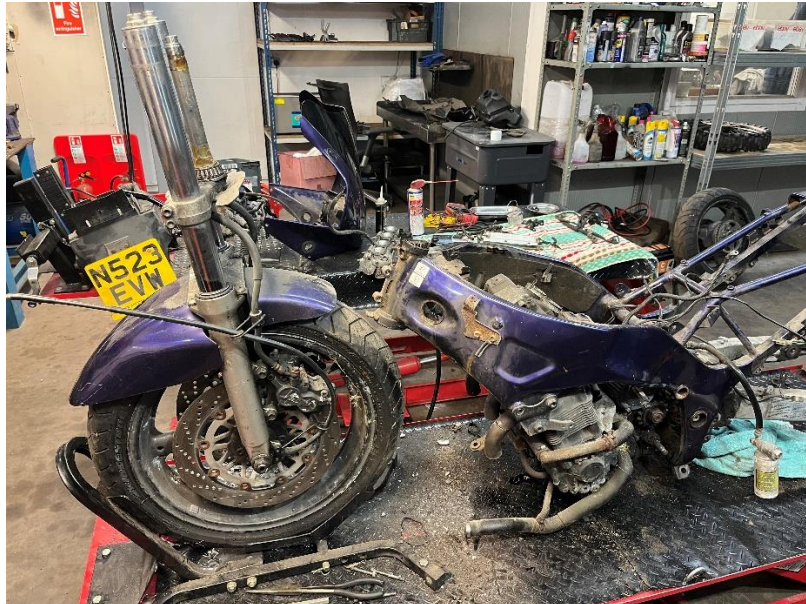
- Remove fan, radiator, oil cooler.
- Remove headers and exhaust.
- Remove wiring harness.



- Remove subframe if applicable
- Strap down the bike to the ramp.
- Remove the brake calipers.
- Remove the wheels.



- Remove the rear shock & linkages.
- Remove the swingarm and linkages
- Remove the front forks.
- Remove the top and bottom yoke.



- Lower the engine and frame from the paddock stand onto the ramp.
- Remove the frame from the engine.



- Dismantle the engine.
- Inspect all part and quarantine parts for scrap.
- Complete scrap quantities / update Dvla.
