It does not alter the need to obtain any other consents or approvals which might be required in connection with your proposal under other legislation. For example it does not give any right or permission to discharge where land is not owned by the applicant.

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

RAG WORM FARM EFFLUENT ("the Discharge")

FROM: WEST MARSH FARM, LAUGHARNE

1. (a) The Discharge shall not contain any poisonous, noxious or polluting matter or solid waste matter.
- (b) Provided that the Discharge hereby consented is made in accordance with the following conditions of this consent, such discharge shall not be taken to be in breach of condition (a) above by reason of containing substances or having properties identified in and controlled by these conditions.

NATURE

2. The Discharge shall consist solely of trade effluent comprising of treated Rag Worm farm effluent.
3. All water abstracted at the inlet for use in the rag worm farm must be passed through the point of discharge and will be regarded as trade effluent.

LOCATION

4. The Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
 - (a) discharging via a 560 mm diameter pipe;
 - (b) discharging to the Taf Estuary;
 - (c) at National Grid Reference SN 3232 0974;
 - (d) shown marked 'Consent Point' on Plan BP0354801 attached as Annex 1.

SAMPLE POINT

4. The inlet to the rag worm farm and the outlet to the receiving water shall be constructed, maintained and appropriately labelled so that a representative sample of the inlet water and the Discharge may be safely obtained at National Grid Reference SN 2880 0853, and SN 2881 7084 respectively, as shown marked 'Influent Sample Point' and 'Effluent sample Point' on Plan BP0354801. The consent holder shall ensure that all constituents of the Discharge pass through the said sampling point at all times and in any legal proceedings it shall, for the purposes of Section 10 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1961, be presumed, until the contrary is shown that any sample of the Discharge taken at the said sampling point is a sample of what was discharging into controlled waters.

VOLUME

5. The volume of the Discharge shall exceed 7200 cubic metres per day.
6. The rate of Discharge shall not exceed 125 litres per second

FLOW MEASUREMENT

7. A continuous flow measurement and recording system, to a specification provided by the Agency, shall be provided and operated to record the total daily volume and the instantaneous or 15-minute integrated flow every 15 minutes of the discharge. An on-site visual display from which instantaneous or 15-minute integrated flow readings can be readily obtained by the Agency shall be provided and operated. The Consent Holder shall hold records of the flow readings.
8. As soon as practicable after completion of the flow system installation and subsequently on the expiry of any certificate issued, the Consent Holder shall employ an independent expert to certify that the installation and its quality management system complies with the Agency's specification. The independent expert shall be accredited to a competency scheme approved by the Agency. A copy of the certificate shall be sent to the Agency and the certifier's report shall be provided to the Agency on request. If a certificate issued for a flow system has no expiry date included then the certificate shall be deemed to expire five years after the issue date of the certificate.
9. The Consent Holder shall produce and maintain a documented quality management system, approved by the independent expert and to the satisfaction of the Agency, specifying procedures for the calibration, operation and maintenance of the flow measurement equipment. The flow measurement equipment shall be calibrated, operated and maintained by the Consent Holder in accordance with the provisions of the QMS. The Consent Holder shall keep a record of these procedures available for inspection by the Agency and provide a copy to the Agency on request

10. The Consent Holder shall record all failures of the continuous flow measurement system and any other breaks in the flow record. The reasons for all significant failures and breaks, which lead to missing or suspect data, and all steps taken to prevent a re-occurrence shall be recorded and details shall be provided to the Agency on request. A failure or break is significant for the purposes of this condition if it prevents the calculation of the total daily volume to the required level of uncertainty. The Consent Holder shall ensure that as far as possible the recorder remains fully operational at all times. Any failures shall be remedied as soon as possible
11. Records of the flow readings or the reasons for any breaks in the record, as described in condition 10 above, shall be provided to the Agency when requested, in a format specified by the Agency
12. Flows of the discharge shall be measured at 'Influent Sample Point' NGR SN 2881 7084

SCREENING

13. The inlet to the rag worm farm and discharge point shall be screened by means of simple mesh screens to the satisfaction of the Agency to prevent ingress of wild fish and escape of farm stock.

COMPOSITION

14. Passage of water through the farm as measured by difference in composition between samples at the Inlet Sample Point SN and Outlet NGR shall not increase:
 - a.) The Biochemical oxygen demand (ATU) at 20⁰C by more than 2 mg/l⁻¹
 - b.) The content of Suspended Solids dried at 105⁰C by more than 5mg/l.
15. The effluent discharged to the relevant waters shall exhibit pH values not less than 6 or greater than 9.
16. The effluent discharged to the relevant waters shall not contain:
 - a.) Any material in quantities sufficient to cause fungal growth in river water below the farm.
 - b.) Any substance in concentration such as to cause the waters to be poisonous or injurious to fish, or the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish

17. The effluent discharged to the relevant waters shall exhibit a content of Dissolved Oxygen not less than 60% of air saturation.
18. As far as is reasonably practicable, the treatment system shall be operated so as to prevent:
 - (a) any matter being present in the Discharge, other than matter specifically covered by numerical conditions in this consent, to such an extent as to cause the receiving waters, or any waters of which the receiving waters are a tributary, to be poisonous or injurious to fish in those waters, or to the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish in those waters, or otherwise cause damage to the ecology of those waters; and
 - (b) the Discharge from having any other adverse environmental impact.
