CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. The following conditions shall replace all previous conditions relating to this discharge.
2. The discharge shall consist only of biologically treated sewage effluent.
3. The discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as follows:-

Discharging via : Existing pipe
Discharging to : River Monnow
At O.S. Grid Ref.: SO 4855 1478
As shown marked : Discharge Point on attached drawing/plan no.
RW/0800/I/1
4. Adequate facilities, approved in writing by the Authority, shall be provided to enable representative samples of the discharge to be safely and conveniently obtained at any time at the outlet to the River Monnow as shown marked 'Sampling Point' on the attached drawing/plan no.
RW/0800/I/1.
5. The maximum daily volume of effluent shall not exceed 55 cubic metres per day.

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

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6. The discharge shall not have any adverse effect on any source of water used for public or private potable supply.
7. As far as is reasonably practicable the works shall be operated so as to prevent any matter being present in the effluent which will cause the receiving water to be poisonous or injurious to fish, their spawn or spawning grounds or food, nor otherwise cause damage to the ecology of the receiving waters or have any adverse visual impact.
8. The works shall be operated and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. In particular the works shall be maintained such that:-
 - a) it remains fully operational except at times of mechanical or electrical breakdown
 - b) any such breakdowns shall be attended to promptly and the equipment returned to normal operation as soon as possible
 - c) tanks shall be desludged at sufficient frequency and in such a manner as to prevent problems with septic sludge, rising sludge or excessive carry over of suspended solids.
