

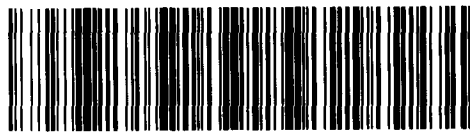

Records held on WIMS show PENNAL STW (CG0075401) to be extant under version 1 issued 30/01/1985 with numeric consent conditions, effective 30/01/1985. The works is currently consented to discharge a max daily volume of 444m³/day effluent to the PENNAL at NGR SN7022099650.

UWWTD directive aims to deliver a standard level of sewage treatment throughout EC member states. This has been interpreted as prescribing a minimum of secondary biological treatment (package plant or equivalent) on all discharges made to a controlled surface water; or a minimum of primary (septic tank or equivalent) treatment on all discharges made to ground.

The discharge of 444m³/day effluent to 'PENNAL', for the purposes of this review, is described as 'secondary treated effluent to surface waters'. This treatment / receiving water combination has been assessed* as APPROPRIATE under the UWWTD review. This consent is reviewed as APPROPRIATE under UWWTD as of 01/09/2005.

* NB: the assessment of this Discharge Consent to meet UWWTD 'appropriate treatment' criteria is based solely on provision of the appropriate 'threshold' level of minimum treatment for the receiving medium. This review does not assess appropriateness in terms of the specific river needs of the receiving water stretch.

CONSENT VARIATION

RIVERS (CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACTS 1951-1961

THE WATER AUTHORITIES (CONTROL OF DISCHARGES) ORDER 1978

I am directed by the Secretary of State for Wales to refer to the discharge consent in respect of the ..PENNAL..... sewage treatment works dated 29...AUGUST.. 1981.

The Secretary of State for Wales, having consulted with the Welsh Water Authority, hereby gives notice that in exercise of his powers under Articles 4(8) and 8 of the Water Authorities (Control of Discharges) Order 1978 (SI 1978 No 1210), the conditions imposed on the said consent shall be varied in the following terms:

CONDITIONS

Th quality and quantity of effluent shall not exceed the following maximum values:

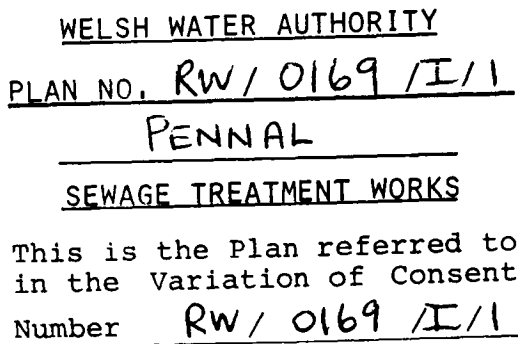

This variation takes effect from the .30. January 1985.

Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1951 - 1961
Pennal and Port Nevegar Sewerage Disposal Scheme

With reference to your application of 14th April 1968, the Gwynedd River Authority, in pursuance of their powers under the above Act, hereby consent to the bringing into use of a new outlet for the discharge of treated sewage effluent and the making of a new discharge of treated sewage effluent into the River Pennal at a point on its left bank in C. . . enclosure No. 47 about 200 yards upstream of the confluence of the River Pennal with the River Dwyryd in accordance with the plan(s) submitted and subject to the following conditions:-

1. The volume of effluent discharged under dry weather flow conditions shall not exceed 30,000 gallons in any period of 24 hours.
2. The discharge shall at no time -
 - (a) contain more than 30 parts per million of suspended matter dried at 105° C.
 - (b) take up more than 20 parts per million of dissolved oxygen in 5 days at 20° C.
3. Suitable sampling facilities shall be provided so as to enable this Authority to exercise its right to sample the effluent before its admixture with the river water.
4. Detailed plans and sections of the headwall to the effluent pipe where it discharges into the River Pennal shall be submitted for the Authority's approval.

The terms of this consent will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this consent is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the period ending with the 1st day of December 1970.
