Apologies for a slow reply on this, your email arrived in the midst of a period of field survey and some annual leave during the Easter Holidays.

I'd be more than happy to arrange a call to look at this from the perspective of marine archaeological material. I have checked our GIS on this, which includes the National Monuments Record, the local HER and Cadw's designated sites, and there is nothing showing within the survey area. There is some potential for unknown buried archaeological material, mainly in the form of shipwreck or aircraft losses that have never been

located. But I'd be happy to talk through this with you directly, and I think a lot of that has been covered in the desk-based work for CML2365.

Good afternoon, Dr Whitewright,

I hope you don't mind the approach out of the blue, but I'm hoping that you can help me with a Band 1 Marine Licence application to NRW.

We are aware that you have been supporting NRW, by providing consultation feedback on our Marine Licence application (CML2365) for a new electrical cable in Liverpool Bay, North Wales.

To support our detailed design process for the cable we need to collect some detailed geological information. To this end we would like to drill a borehole, and conduct a non-intrusive geophysical survey, on Talacre Beach in North Wales at the location shown in the attached location plans. We will access the proposed location via the Talacre Beach car park.

We would be grateful for your assistance, as the Band 1 Marine Licence application requires that we need confirmation that RCAHWW are satisfied that our work will not have a negative impact on any archaeological features.
