Good afternoon, Trevor,

I hope you don't mind the approach out of the blue, but I'm hoping that you can help me with a Band 1 Marine Licence application to NRW.

We are aware that you have been supporting NRW, by providing consultation feedback on our Marine Licence application (CML2365) for a new electrical cable in Liverpool Bay, North Wales.

To support our detailed design process for the cable we need to collect some detailed geological information. To this end we would like to drill a borehole, and conduct a non-intrusive geophysical survey, on Talacre Beach in North Wales at the location shown in the attached location plans. We will access the proposed location via the Talacre Beach car park.

We would be grateful for your assistance, as the Band 1 Marine Licence application requires that we need confirmation from Trinity House that our work would not pose a risk to others.

Would it be possible to arrange a call with you to run through our plans and provide you with this reassurance?
