I am pleased to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, has considered For the Love of the Sea Limited application dated 02 April 2025 to a Marine Licence under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, and hereby grant the Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence DEML2013v1 and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence DEML2013v1 supersedes Marine Licence DEML2013 in its entirety.

The marine licence has been varied to extend the expiry date by 1 year, from 31 July 2025 to 31 July 2026.

I would also like to take this opportunity to make clear that since the licence has been extended by 1 year to the 31 July 2026, decommissioning of the deposited equipment licenced under DEML2013v1 (20 mussel floats and suspended trial equipment) must be fully removed by the expiry date of the licence.

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, DEML2013v1, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, DEML2013v1 is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.
