Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to prevent a recurrence of the incident	<p><b>We are implementing a control system upgrade for the three pumps currently protected by trip switches. These trip switches will be replaced with contactors. With the new configuration, if there is a loss of power, the pumps will no longer require manual reset—once power is restored, the contactors will automatically re-engage and restart the pumps.</b></p> <p><b>Additionally, the crude pit pumps will be interlocked with the dairy drain valve. In the event the pumps stop running, the system will automatically close the drain valve, preventing any further liquid from entering the crude pit.</b></p> <p><b>To further enhance protection, the system will also monitor the crude pit's high-level alarm. If this alarm is triggered, the drain valve will automatically close to prevent overflow.</b></p>

	However, the crude pit pumps will continue to operate until the high-level condition is cleared.
