Letter of withdrawal of your deployment approval

Deployment Reference: *PAN-026421*

We are writing to advise you that your deployment reference *PAN-026421* is formally withdrawn as of the date of this letter.

Our decision to withdraw your deployment is based on the factors set out below.

- Causing pollution to drainage ditches within the deployment area. This a breach of permit condition 3.2.1.
- Spreading waste not in compliance with the agreed deployment, through spreading low pH waste to low pH soils. This is a breach of permit conditions 2.1.1, 2.1.5.
- Failure to keep/provide accurate records of spreading activity at the registered deployment. This is a breach of permit condition 2.1.6.

For further information regarding the above non-compliances please see CAR forms issued in relation to the deployment on 11/02/2025 & 11/04/2025.

Although a response was provided by the company as to why they believe the permit should not be withdrawn. The reasons given were not deemed sufficient to alter our enforcement response.

The company stated that they do not intent to carry out further spreading. This is not a sufficient reason for the deployment not to be withdrawn.

The company also stated as the pollutant came from clean water treatment 'it has no significant contamination qualities other than silt'. This statement is incorrect.

We would like to remind you that where aluminium content is high, operators should take care to prevent the waste entering a watercourse because aluminium can harm aquatic life. Silt pollution also has the the potential to cause a significant detrimental impact to the water environment.

You are not permitted to carry out any further waste operations (including storage) under the terms of this deployment. Should you intend to carry out any waste operations you must obtain authorisation from us prior to starting any operations. Should you carry out any waste operations without authorisation you may be subject to enforcement action.

If you are not satisfied with the service you have been provided then we would respectfully direct you to our complaints procedure on our website.
