CONDITIONS OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

Biologically-treated Sewage in an Emergency ("the Discharge")

FROM: Penmaenmawr Wastewater Treatment Works

NATURE

1. The Discharge shall consist solely of secondary-treated sewage in an emergency.
2. The Discharge shall only occur when the sewage pumping station is inoperative as a result of one or more of the following:
 - (i) electrical power failure not due to the act or default of the consent holder, its agents, representatives, officers, employees or servants;
 - (ii) mechanical breakdown of duty and standby pumps;
 - (iii) rising main failure;
 - (iv) blockage of the downstream sewer not due to the act or default of the consent holder, its agents, representatives, officers, employees or servants;

and it is not reasonably practicable to dispose of the sewage otherwise. There shall be no undue delay on the part of the consent holder in remedying any such failure or breakdown.

LOCATION

3. (a) From the 1st June 2001 until 31st October 2001 inclusive, or the end of commissioning of the pumping station, whichever is the sooner, the Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
 - (i) discharging via a 700 millimetre diameter pipe;
 - (ii) discharging to the Afon Gyrach;
 - (iii) at National Grid Reference SH 7353 7780;
 - (iv) shown marked 'Temporary Consent Point' on Plan CG0393901 attached as Annex 2.

3. (b) From the 1st November 2001 onwards, or the end of commissioning of the pumping station, whichever is the sooner, the Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
- (i) discharging via a 700 millimetre diameter pipe;
 - (ii) discharging to Conwy Bay coastal waters;
 - (iii) at National Grid Reference SH 7322 7811;
 - (iv) shown marked 'Consent Point' on Plan CG0393901 attached as Annex 2.

SAMPLE POINT

4. A sample point shall be provided by 1st June 2001 and maintained at National Grid Reference SH 7371 7799, as shown marked 'Sample Point' on Plan CG0393901, so that a representative sample of the Discharge may be obtained. The consent holder shall ensure that all constituents of the Discharge pass through the said sampling point at all times and in any legal proceedings it shall, for the purposes of Section 10 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1961, be presumed, until the contrary is shown that any sample of the Discharge taken at the said sampling point is a sample of what was discharging into controlled waters.

COMPOSITION

5. (a) The Discharge shall have passed, without prior comminution or maceration, through a screening device having apertures no greater than 6 millimetres in two dimensions.
- (b) The screening device shall be maintained in an efficient operational condition.
- (c) All screenings must be removed and disposed of in a manner such as to prevent entry to the discharge.

RECORDING AND REPORTING

6.
 - (a) The consent holder shall establish and operate a documented maintenance programme and record all non-routine actions undertaken that may have adversely affected effluent quality. Copies of the programme shall be made available for inspection by the Agency's officers at all reasonable times.
 - (b) On request the consent holder shall supply the Agency with a written report on the maintenance and all non-routine actions that may have adversely affected effluent quality .
7. The consent holder shall notify the Agency in writing if any known or planned introduction or material change in respect of discharges from trade premises to the sewerage system occurs, that may increase or introduce into the effluent any "dangerous substance" (set out in Annex 1 to this notice as updated from time to time and notified to the consent holder in writing), and any other substance considered by the consent holder as having or likely to have a significant effect on the receiving waters.

TELEMETRY and MAINTENANCE

8.
 - (a) A 24 hour response telemetry alarm system shall be provided by 1st June 2001 and maintained to give notification of failure or breakdown of the pumping station.
 - (b) The consent holder shall take all reasonable remedial measures to return the pumping station to normal operation, as soon as practicable after warning of failure or breakdown of the pumping station.
 - (c) The consent holder shall notify the Agency, as soon as practicable, when there is potential for operation of the emergency overflow in the event of failure or breakdown of the pumping station.
9. On request the consent holder shall supply the Agency with a written report on the operation of the emergency overflow.
10. A permanent stand-by power generator shall be provided by 1st June 2001 and maintained in good working order.
11. The duty pump shall be maintained in good working order, and at least one stand-by pump shall be provided and maintained.

12. Stand-by pumps shall automatically activate should the duty pumps become inoperative for reasons other than power failure. The pumping station shall be maintained so that the pump shall automatically reactivate immediately after the power is restored after interruption to the supply.
13. A tanker access facility at an appropriate location shall be provided and maintained to enable removal of sewage by tanker when necessary.

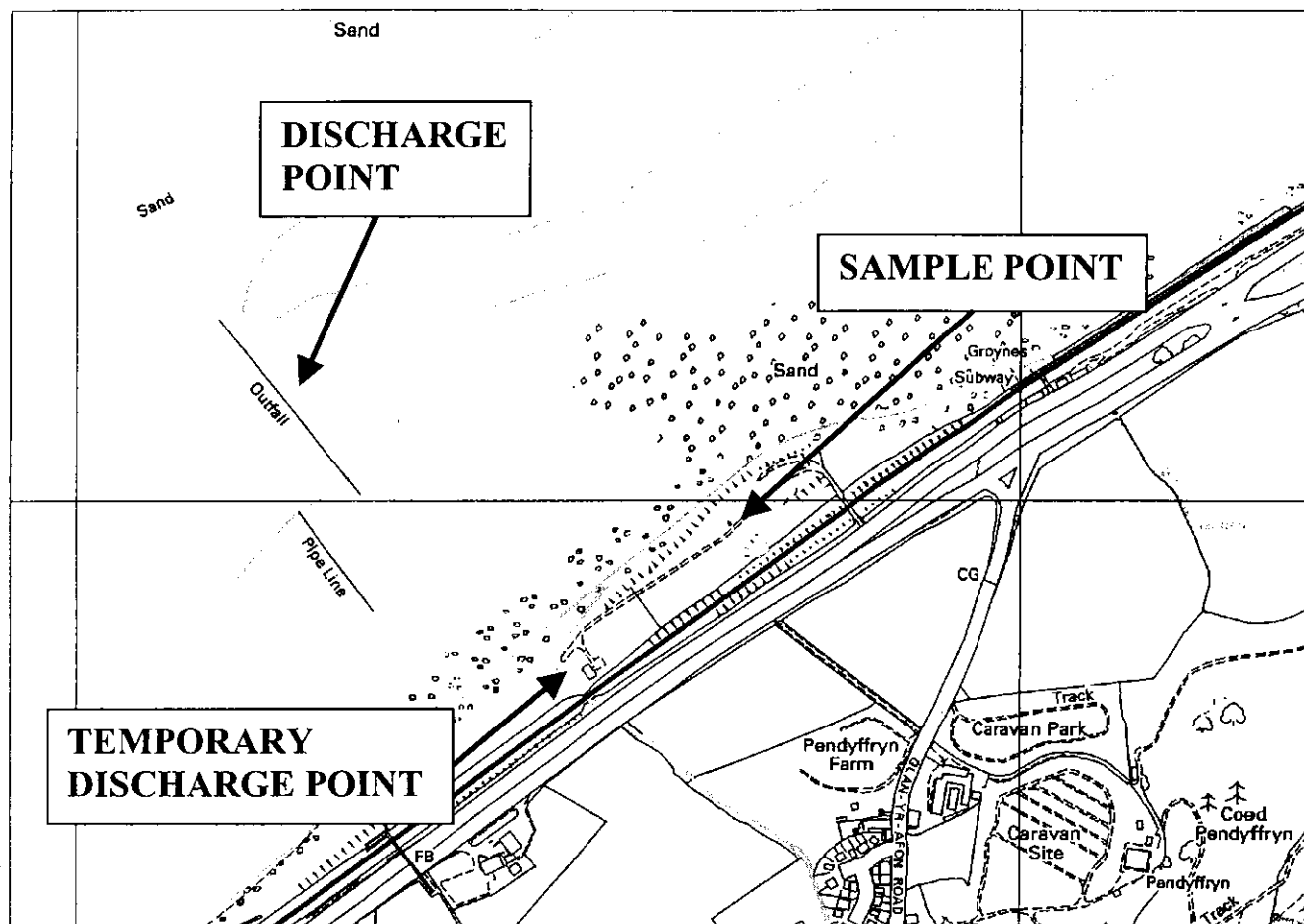

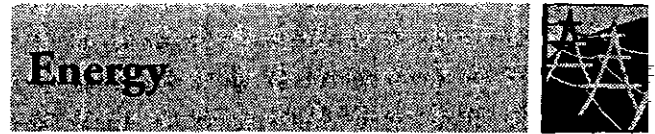

With reference to the discharge of drilling mud and cuttings the mud chemicals fall mainly into HOCNS Group E, with some 84 per cent of the total mud chemical usage being PLONOR List Substances. Cuttings dispersion modelling suggests rapid dispersion in the deep waters, resulting in no expected impact beyond the immediate top-hole cuttings pile.

Atmospheric emissions are expected to be within routine drilling rig operational standards, with estimated emissions presented in the FS for drilling and support operations.

The FS discusses noise generation and potential impacts (section 6.5) and places emphasis on the short-term nature of the drilling operation. No significant impact was identified.

The FS identifies that the most likely spill risk arises from bunkering but states that spills of a light distillate fuel oil would disperse extremely rapidly, with "negligible" environmental impact.

In addressing the risk of a blow-out, CUKL cites low probability based on drilling experience to date on the UKCS.

After a request by DTI, Conoco provided more adequate information regarding the basis to the selection of the drill-ship and its assessment of potential risks from the use of the vessel for drilling well 132/06-A, particularly in relation to oil spill risk.

No significant impact was identified from the drilling of this well. Both JNCC and FRS agree. The drilling of this well is unlikely to impact any future potential SAC. (1002)
