A representative from Vale Engineering and Welsh Water were also on site

The first part of the site visit Richard Safadi went through the plan for improvements to the site.

This included connection to foul sewer. A representative from Vale Consultancy explained that they had carried out a site survey with a view to install a drainage system that would allow connection to the foul sewer. This would involve installation of a silt trap, full retention oil interceptor, a balancing tank, a meter and creating a sample point.

Richard Safadi estimated that this work would start around Easter next year.

We assessed the site against each of the outstanding actions from the Compliance Assessment Report CAR_NRW0035594.

All batteries were to be taken into the building or provide a lid for the container of batteries being stored outside. There were no batteries being stored outside therefore the site had carried out this action.

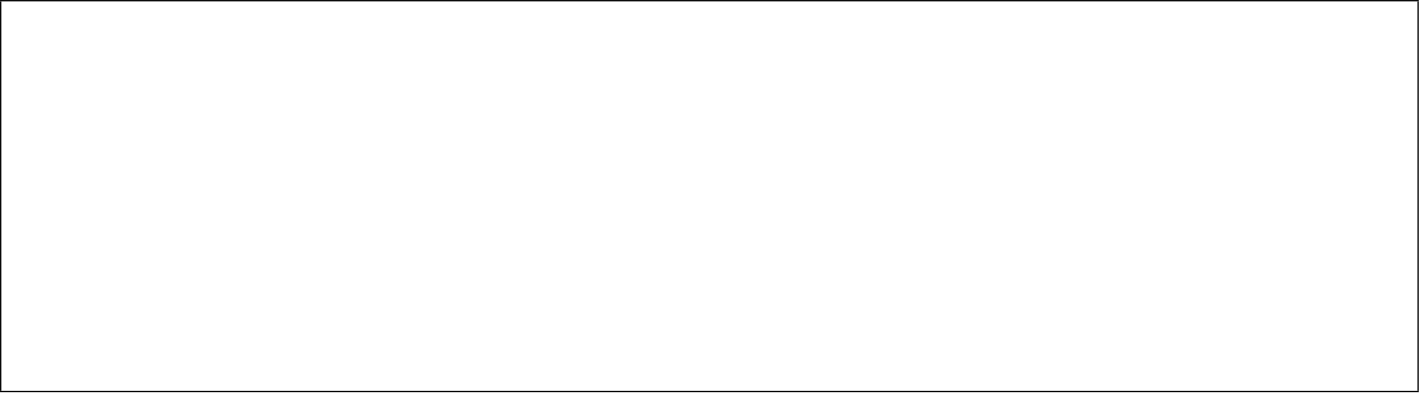
All scrap was removed from the ELV permitted area and all ELVs were removed from the T9 exempt area.

A site plan will be produced and referenced SW6213SW. This plan will be modified as and when the site improvements are made.

It could be seen that operations have improved on site and much waste in the form of ELVs and scrap metal has been removed off site. Ammanford Metals appear to be moving in the right direction with improvements being investigated to the site infrastructure and staff training being improved also.

We received was documentation for the incoming waste and outgoing waste on the dates specified in Compliance Assessment Report CAR_NRW0035594.

Please note: as specified in your EMS, all waste shall be stored on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage system, except for uncontaminated plastic, glass, ferrous and non-ferrous metal waste arising from the treatment of end of life vehicles, which may be stored on a hardstanding. This would also be authorised on the T9 exemption. However, depolluted ELVs would need to be stored on a Sealed drainage system.
