Dear Sir/ Madam

Our original Abstraction licence was for 40,000 cubes per annum.

In 2017 our then General Manager Huw Morgan decided not to renew our license without consulting with then then Board of the Golf Club. It has recently come to light during a visit by NRW's Gareth Martin that our reduced license is now only 15,000 cubes per year. Which has been enough over recent years for our irrigation system on the golf course.

It has always been the plan of the golf club to install fairway irrigation to protect our main asset of the golf club and its members, with current climate change and changes to the seasons, dry spring periods we are now finding ourselves needing to plan to install fairway irrigation imminently. To go ahead with this £500,000 installation we would need to be guaranteed the total of our original abstraction license per annum of 40,000 cubes. It has been calculated that during an extreme dry drought season between April and October we would be using between 25,000 and 38,000 cubes of water in total, depending on the severity of the drought.

With significant cost to our members for this irrigation installation to go ahead we need to be able to guarantee them that our water capacity and abstraction license is back to our original license amount and the longevity is guaranteed to protect their asset.

Pennard Golf Club attracts visitors from all around the world and employs between 30-40 local staff with over 700 playing members, without fairway irrigation being installed we are very concerned we cannot produce the golf course that has given us Top Rankings in the UK.

We are hopeful that returning to our pre 2017 license agreement of 40,000 cubes per year is possible with an agreed duration period that would able us to protect our main asset being the golf course and produce for the local community.
