3.18.2 Biosecurity Risk Assessment

As you will have seen from recent email correspondence we have been in discussions with NRW Advisory regarding the formulation of a more workable approach to the Biosecurity requirements for Milford Haven. These discussions are on-going, but I think that we are probably very close to finalising a risk assessment that aligns better with the contracting framework. However, we have recently received tenders for an imminent maintenance dredging need for the Pembroke Power Station intake channel. Although the tender evaluation process is still to be finalised, I wanted to progress the matter of the Biosecurity Risk Assessment for the TSHD vessel 'Sospan Dau' at the earliest opportunity as dredging might commence at the beginning of September.

In compliance with Condition 3.18.2 please find attached the Biosecurity Risk Assessment for the vessel 'Sospan Dau', provided by the vessels operator Boskalis Westminster Ltd. The risk assessment is broadly similar to that provided last year for the dredger 'Shoalway', also operated by Boskalis, which was approved by NRW. It is also pertinent that the vessel is presently anticipated to be transiting to Milford Haven from Cardiff, so will be arriving from a port within the same biosecurity water body.

I trust that the attached is to your satisfaction but should you require any additional information please let me know.
