Install a new flap / screen / cover on the existing SPS Emergency outfall pipe / headwall, located on the grassed area adjacent to the pumping station at Aberffraw.

Concerns have been raised by the local authority about the existing condition of the structure and the risk to the public with slip, trips & falls.
