Severn Estuary CIP4 sediment grab surveys

Briefly describe the low risk band 1 activities you will be carrying out.

For example:

Carrying out minor maintenance on a pier, including installing scaffolding, replacing bolts and decking, then removing scaffolding (construction activity example) Collecting twelve sediment samples from the sea bed (removal activity example) Depositing five marker buoys (deposit activity example) Brushing wind-blown sand back onto the beach where it came from (beach management activity example)

Note this application has previously been submitted with Ref RML2551 - this re-submission has the additional information requested. A fee has already been paid for RML2551.

Benthic grab samples will be collected to obtain chemistry data for sediments in the Severn Estuary. A single grab sample will be collected at three stations anticipated to be in NRW waters (SWE2, SWE3 and SWE4).

Samples will be collected using a Van Veen benthic grab which will sample a surface area of 0.1m² only.

The maximum volume of sediment to be sampled at each station is 12 litres (0.012 m³).

Across the three stations a maximum of 36 litres of sediment would be collected (0.036 m³) on each survey.

There will be two surveys. One survey will be conducted between 15th and 22nd September; and one survey will be conducted in winter (likely January but dates are to be confirmed).

Across both surveys the maximum volume of sediment to be sampled is 72 litres (0.072 m³).

Note that for the vessel track section of this submission, another station is indicated (SWE1) - this is outside Welsh waters so it not relevant to this license submission but is has been included in the vessel track figure as it will influence the vessel route taken for the sampling.
