

Hi Mike,

Thank you for getting in touch, and to Sean for copying me in. Certain works that fall under Band 1 can carry archaeological implications so we had a meeting with NRW and RCAHMW last year, to discuss establish where we need to be consulted by NRW - these are mainly in the intertidal zone. We collectively agreed that sampling excursions such as this didn't require consultation with us or any bespoke action, but there is a standing obligation to report any new discoveries, and there may be some generic guidance on this accompanying the licence when issued.

I've been asked to obtain an NRW marine licence for some routine sediment sampling that we undertake here as part of our teaching and research programmes.

I'm completing an online application and as in previous years we require confirmation that our planned activities do not have any significant negative impacts on various aspects of the marine environment.
