Works can continue provided a suitably qualified ecologist has surveyed the watercourse 2 hours before high tide and confirmed qualifying species of the Special Protection Area are outside of the likely disturbance zone (and not expected to move within this zone during the working period). Particular caution is to be practised when working around high tides.
