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Dear All,

Just picking up on your email, forwarded to me from our enquiries team about the proposed geotechnical work in relation to the Fishguard Linkspan. Thanks for forwarding the method statement, etc.

I can confirm that we have no concerns with regard to any impact to known marine archaeological material. There is the possibility of encountering unknown material during the work, and I have attached a Protocol for Archaeological Discoveries that can offer guidance in the event of previously unknown archaeological material being found in the course of the work. I am happy to act as a direct contact if needed.

More widely, the work has potential to enhance current knowledge regarding the presence/absence of any prehistoric land surfaces in the area - usually signalled by the presence of peat deposits, etc. As such, we would be very grateful if it was possible to forward any geological/geotechnical reports arising from the work as a means to add the location of any such prehistoric material to the National Monuments Record of Wales.

I'd be happy to discuss any of the above directly, if needed.
