Records held on WIMS show BRO ELIDIR STW DINORWIC , (CG0023702) to be extant under version 1 issued 15/02/1993 with numeric consent conditions, effective 15/02/1993. The works is currently consented to discharge a max daily volume of UNSPECIFIEDm³/day effluent to the TRIB OF AFON FACHWEN at NGR SH5842061700.

UWWTD directive aims to deliver a standard level of sewage treatment throughout EC member states. This has been interpreted as prescribing a minimum of secondary biological treatment (package plant or equivalent) on all discharges made to a controlled surface water; or a minimum of primary (septic tank or equivalent) treatment on all discharges made to ground.

The discharge of UNSPECIFIEDm³/day effluent to 'TRIB OF AFON FACHWEN', for the purposes of this review, is described as 'irrelevant (intermittent discharge that does not qualify under UWWTD)'. This treatment / receiving water combination has been assessed* as NON UWWTD under the UWWTD review. This consent is reviewed as NON UWWTD under UWWTD as of 01/09/2005.

* NB: the assessment of this Discharge Consent to meet UWWTD 'appropriate treatment' criteria is based solely on provision of the appropriate 'threshold' level of minimum treatment for the receiving medium. This review does not assess appropriateness in terms of the specific river needs of the receiving water stretch.

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. The discharge shall consist only of sewage discharged in an emergency to avoid danger to life or health. An electrical or mechanical breakdown of such severity as to render the treatment works completely inoperable, total failure of the external power supply or total blockage of the influent sewer shall be considered an emergency. An emergency shall not include works shut-down to facilitate maintenance or refurbishment.
2. The discharge shall only take place when it is not reasonably practicable to dispose of the sewage by other means.

The discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as

3. follows:-

Discharging via : 160 mm pipe
Discharging to : A tributary of the Afon Fachwen

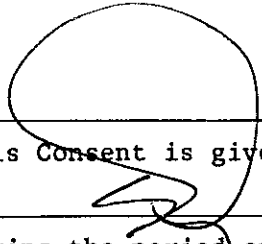

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4. Equipment shall be provided to remove all unacceptable solid matter from the effluent prior to discharge, as approved in writing by the Authority.
5. A plug in facility shall be provided for emergency power supply to the works in event of external power supply failure.
6. The Authority shall be notified of any discharge as soon as reasonably practicable and in any case within 24 hours.
7. All reasonable practicable steps shall be taken to minimise the duration of the discharge and its polluting effects.
8. The discharger shall pay all reasonable costs to the Authority in relation to any anti-pollution works or operations carried out in respect of poisonous, noxious or polluting matter or solid waste matter present in the waters as a result of the discharge.
