Hello Steffan

thanks for the information and your help with this so far. However, I am still a bit confused.

I have attached a map showing the information we hold and I still have some queries that I hope you can help me resolve.

Environmental permits contain the grid reference for the point at which the discharge to the environment takes place (often a headwall to a river).

Thank you for supplying me with a copy of the permit BP0251501. As you can see from the attached map, permit BP0251501 seems to refer to a location about 450 metres away from the pumping station at the Enterprise Centre. You can also see on the map that a sewer (purple line) seems to come from the pumping station and lead to a waterbody much closer to the Enterprise centre. It was this outfall that I thought the planning application referred to but I cannot find a permit for this. Maybe it is not an outfall.

Sorry this is a bit complicated. It may be best if we try and resolve this via a phone call and/or a site visit rather than using email so I will give you a ring to discuss it further.

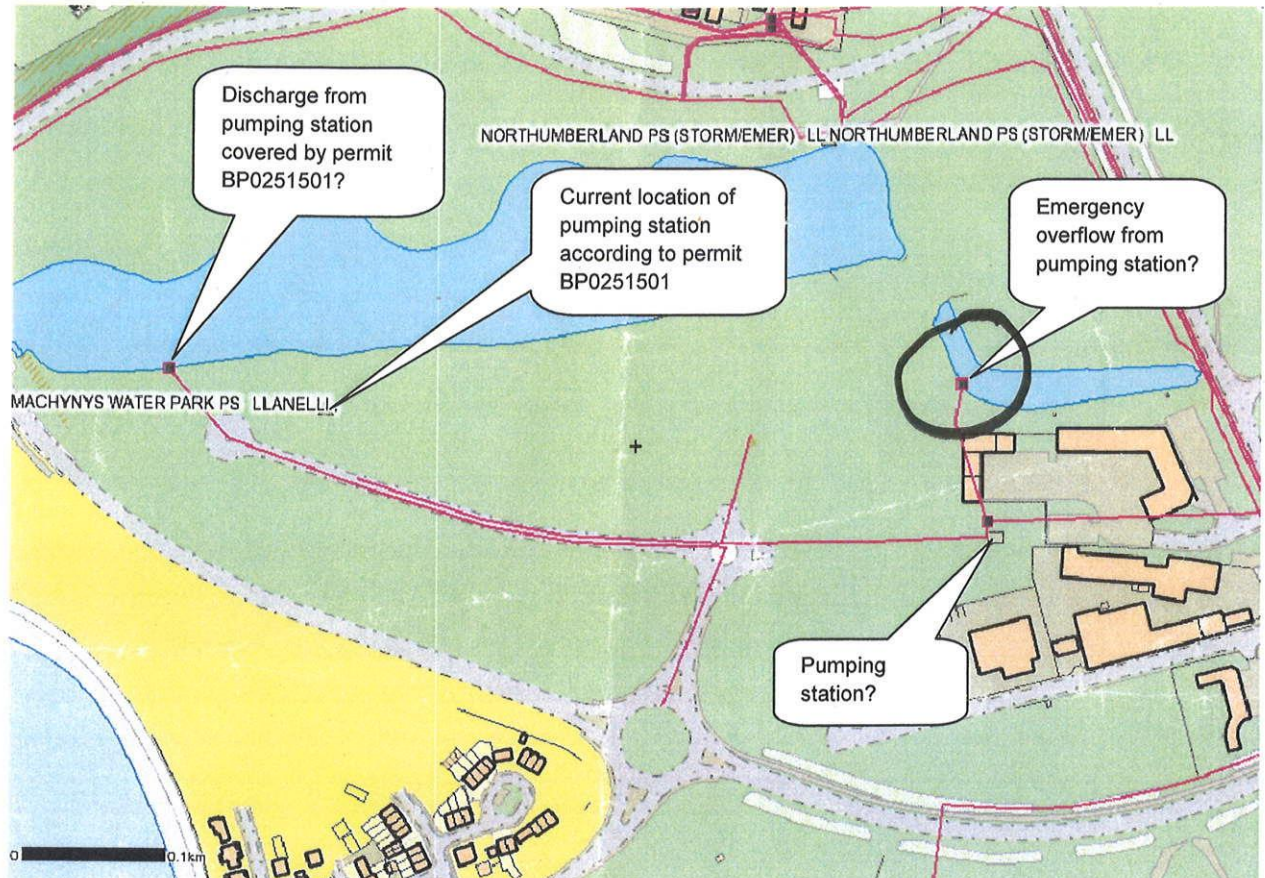
