Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

Valero Pembrokeshire Oil Terminal (VPOT) Ltd. are varying their permit EPR/BK1341IN to reflect changes to the site as a result of the reinstatement of the Cross-Haven pipeline between VPOT and Pembroke Refinery (EPR/YP3930EX) operated by Valero Energy Limited. This results in the following changes to the site:

- Addition of the transfer of crude via the Cross-Haven pipeline as an associated activity in the permit.
- Addition of pipework within the installation boundary associated with the Cross Haven pipeline.
- Addition of a new loading arm at berth 2.

The crude is received by ship and is stored in three storage tanks (9, 11 and 12). These tanks were already permitted to store crude and had done when the site was operating as a refinery. The crude is sent to Pembroke Refinery via the Cross-Haven pipeline where it is either processed or stored. Slop oil and dewatering effluent generated on site may also be sent to Pembroke Refinery (either by the pipeline, ship or lorry) for further treatment at that site's effluent treatment plant.

The variation also lists the API oil separator for the treatment of effluent as a directly associated activity. This is an existing activity on site that had been assessed as part of the previous BRef review (permit version V007) but was not listed in the permit as a separate activity.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit.
