**Partial surrender of your permit is complete**

Our determination of your application to surrender part of your permit is complete. In respect of that part of the permit to be surrendered, we're satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility, and to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state, having regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation. We therefore accept the partial surrender. This takes effect from 18 November 2019.
