Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016

Environmental Permit EPR-ZP3933NJ

Please find enclosed a Notice pursuant to Regulation 37(1) and (5) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. This Notice suspends the environmental permit to the extent specified in schedule 1 and you are instructed to cease accepting waste within the boundary of the permit with immediate effect.

Natural Resources Wales has taken this step as it considers that the manner in which you operate your facility contravenes environmental permit conditions and that these contraventions pose a risk of pollution to the environment.

Schedule 2 and 3 of the Notice lists the steps that are required to be complied with before NRW will consider withdrawing this suspension notice. Once the steps have been complied with and NRW is satisfied that the risk of pollution has been removed, then the suspension Notice will be withdrawn.

The appeal provisions available to you are explained within the Notice.
