Transfer for abstraction & Impoundment Water Resources Act 1991 (as amended by the Water Act 2003)

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 37 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and Regulation 6 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006 that an application has been made to Natural Resources Wales by Cardiff City Council for a licence to transfer water from Nant Glandulas at National Grid Reference ST 20615 80760 for the purpose of transferring it to Pentwyn Lake at National Grid Reference ST 20668 80722, at the following rates and periods: 3.96 cubic metres and hour, 95.04 cubic metres a day and 34,689.6 cubic metres a year, all year.

The water will be abstracted for the purpose of transferring it between the sources of supply referred to above without intervening use.

Application is also being made for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of Pentwyn Lake at National Grid Reference ST 20789 80653 at Pentwyn, Cardiff. The object of impounding water by means of the works is to maintain the lake level.

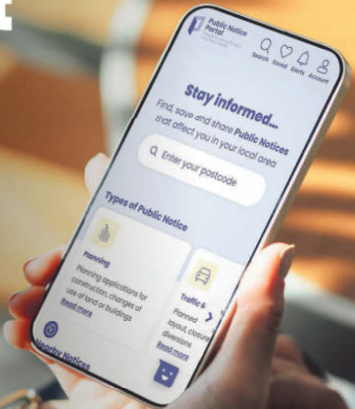
