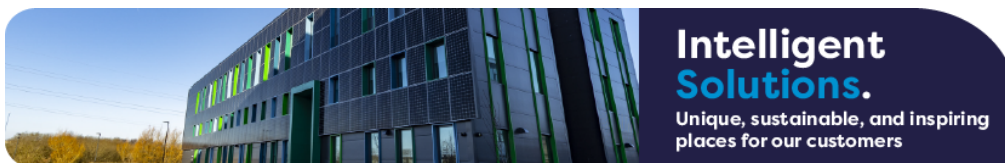

Morning Steve,

I'll look to get the application sorted today. NRW note on their website that a standard permit variation could take 3-4 months. This may be quicker though given it's such a small change.

Last week I misread NRW's guidance on variation fees. To clarify:

- If NRW deem that the change of outlet location does not require a new technical assessment, the variation is classed as an Administrative variation, with a fee of £374.
- If NRW decide that a technical assessment is required, the variation becomes a Normal variation, with a fee of £5,280.

It is unlikely that a new technical assessment will be required given we are moving the outlet point only slightly north.

Below are proposed costs to undertake this:

- NRW Administrative Fees: £374
- Completion of NRW Permit Variation: £275 (0.5x days)
- Correspondence with NRW during the application - £137.50 (2 hours)

Please let us know if you're happy for us to proceed on this basis

Also, how are things on site currently with the rain, is everything being managed okay with the current drainage strategy layout?
