Please find attached the following document. I understand you were both involved in the existing Environmental Permit **EPR/CB3997ZY**, and I am contacting you to make you aware of a number of minor amendments relating to the King Henry VIII Secondary School development on Old Hereford Road, Abergavenny.

As detailed in the note, we would like to highlight that the existing Environmental Permit already encompasses the entire site, including the full Phase 2 working area. The proposed amendments do not introduce any changes to the permitted activity, treatment process, discharge rates or environmental risk. They relate solely to updated logistics for Phase 2, including the relocation of the temporary outfall point and the use of a tank based temporary storage system, all of which remain within the existing permitted boundary and scope.

On this basis, we kindly request NRW's confirmation that these minor updates can be accepted as a logistical update under the current permit, without the need for a formal variation.
