I'm writing to let you know that your application, received on 17 July 2019, is duly made as of 10 September 2019.

Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and decide whether or not we can allow what you've asked for. If we have to refuse your application, we'll explain why.

We may need to ask you for more information during determination. If we do, we'll write to you to explain what we need and how long you have to reply.

Our Customer Charter explains that as long as you have provided us with all the information we need and there are no complicating factors such as confidentiality decisions, you can expect us to determine your application within four months.

We want to give you a decision as quickly as possible, but the time it takes depends on what's in the application. We may need to agree a longer timescale with you:

- if the application is complex;
- if we need to ask you for more information about the technical aspects of your application;
- if there's a considerable level of interest from the public or other organisations.

As previously discussed, NRW has a policy of increased consultation on applications where we consider there is, or is likely to be a high degree of public interest. We feel that the application in question does have the potential to generate said levels of interest in the area, and as such we feel it sensible to approach in this manner. We will be developing an approach which may include one or more of the following:

- Extending any consultation
- Wider advertising e.g. newspapers / social media
- Consulting on the draft permit and decision document

We will advertise this application on our website. We explain more about this in our Public Participation Statement.

We will be in contact next week to discuss the next stage, we will also outline our proposed start date for the public consultation.

If we are unable to determine your application within the time agreed with you, you have the option to consider the application deemed refused. However, we will always work with you to agree a timescale for our determination.
