

NOTICE BY A SECTION 28G AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT AN OPERATION LIKELY TO DAMAGE SPECIAL INTEREST ON A SITE OF SPECIAL SCIENTIFIC INTEREST (SSSI)

I hereby give notice under Section 28 H of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended) of my proposal to carry out, cause or permit to be carried out the operation(s) specified below:-

1.	Details of proposed operation or change in land or water management. Attach method statements, photographs or diagrams if these will help to explain your proposals.
	The existing 9" CI outfall pipe, from the tidal tank, has blocked or fractured resulting in a spill in the upper beach area with no pass forward flow to the existing outfall. In order to maintain the outfall in agreement with NRW a shorter temporary outfall has been put into operation. This was achieved by breaking into the existing damaged outfall at the toe of the shingle bank, to form a temporary discharge point. The exposed pipework at this location is badly cracked for an unknown length downstream of the temporary discharge point and can be considered in poor to very poor condition. The condition of the exposed pipework under the shingle bank (upstream of the temporary discharge point) is not known but is highly likely to be badly corroded. Replacement of the damaged pipework and the adjacent sections is therefore considered the most appropriate repair method. The replacement length will be from the existing valve chamber to a point to be determined by trial hole - this is shown as "Localised Repair 1". The 40m length of replacement is considered to be the most likely scenario. This will be subject to possible reduction of in length or may increase subject to the proposed trial excavation. The aim will be to undertake the minimum amount of replacement practically possible to do and maintain a reasonable lifespan for the asset. There is evidence of a break in the outfall approximately 150 metres down the beach from the shingle bank. This may be at the location of a previous repair and may also be the cause of the outfall failure. It is proposed as part of the works to undertake a short repair at this location, minimum 3m, exact length may

increase subject to proposed trial excavations. On the contract drawing this repair is shown as - Localised Repair 2.

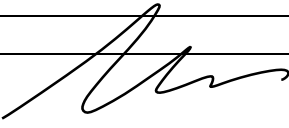
