### 4. Details of our assessment

This was a routine unannounced site inspection carried out at Ambipar Site Services Ltd.

The inspection was carried out by Waste Regulation Officer Amy Henderson. The weather at the time was dry and sunny. There had been heavy rain in the days leading up to the inspection.

A walk around of the site was carried out, accompanied by the Yard Supervisor and Site Environment Officer.

The site was tidy and any waste that was on site appeared well managed and stored in line with permit conditions. All waste was seen to be stored within bays or skips.

WEEE waste was being kept undercover in a curtain sided container.

Asbestos was kept within lockable sealed skips as required.

Waste still remains on site from a lorry fire which happened in 2023. The case is still going through legal proceedings, as detailed on previous CAR form CAR\_NRW0045803. Whilst this is the case the site has been unable to dispose of this waste. The waste is however being managed onsite and is stored inside within a bunded building. Following the inspection an email was sent to site requesting details of how they plan to manage the situation going forward. It was reiterated to the site that the waste cannot remain onsite indefinitely. A response has been received from the company that they have further contacted the producer of the waste confirming this needs to be removed from site. As the waste has been onsite for some time now, an action for this waste to be removed from site has been given within this CAR form.

A check of waste returns show these have been submitted to date.

There were no permit breaches identified as a result of this site inspection.
