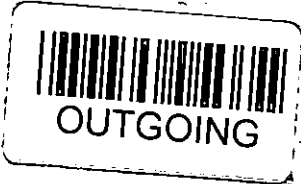

SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF LAND AT SEA VIEW FARM,
ASTON HILL, HAWARDEN

1. This licence shall enure for the benefit of D. Morgan (Plant Hire) Limited and shall expire 5 years from the date of expiry of the previous licence.
2. The licence relates to the access road and area of land delineated in blue on Drawing No. TB 5671/88 attached.
3. No waste material shall be deposited outside the area delineated in red on Drawing No. TB.5671/88 attached to this licence.
4. Only inert non-toxic non-leachate producing wastes, rock, sand, builder's hardcore, subsoil, topsoil and similar excavated material shall be deposited on the site. No materials may be deposited in containers of any description.

Note:

Off-cuts of ferrous and non-ferrous metals, scrap timber, plastic and paper may be deposited when mixed with waste building and civil engineering materials, provided that the maximum amount tipped in any one load does not exceed 10% of the volume of the material in that one load.

5. No other materials shall be deposited on the site without the prior written consent of the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
6. During prolonged periods of dry weather steps shall be taken to prevent any nuisance being caused from dust arising from the site including, where necessary, dampening down of the materials deposited.
7. All plant and machinery used for the operation of this site shall be fitted with efficient silencers which shall be maintained in correct working order such that the sound levels outside the boundary of the site due to noise arising from the operations shall not exceed 60 dB(A) Leq 8 hrs Monday to Friday with a maximum sound level of 80 dB(A) for any 3 minute period.
8. The deposit of farm slurry and farm effluent is expressly forbidden.

9. No surface burning of controlled waste shall be permitted on the site. All deposited material shall be thoroughly compacted and at the end of each working day exposed metal, timber, polythene and paper shall be covered and similarly compacted so that it does not become a harbourage for vermin and to prevent the ingress of surface water.
10. The site be fenced and secured with a locked gate to the satisfaction of the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
11. The site shall be properly supervised during times of operation by a responsible person with power to act on behalf of the Licensee.
12. A suitable weatherproof sign shall be erected in a prominent position at the site entrance and maintained at all times to the satisfaction of the Waste Disposal Authority detailing the name and address and telephone number of that Authority and the site operator.
13. Site operations shall only be carried out between the hours of 8.00 a.m. - 5.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive and from 8.00 a.m. - 4.30 p.m. on Saturdays. No operations shall take place on Sundays, Bank or Public Holidays without the prior approval of the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
14. The applicant shall be responsible for ensuring that all vehicles leaving the site do not carry mud or other debris onto the public highway and shall be responsible for the immediate removal of any such material which may be so deposited.
15. Prior to the commencement of the filling operation a plan shall be submitted for final approval to the Alyn and Deeside D.C. clearly indicating the proposed method of operation.
16. No tipping shall take place into water. The applicant shall be responsible for taking such steps as are considered necessary by the Alyn and Deeside District Council for the removal of any standing water prior to the commencement of the filling operation.
17. The final level of the site shall not exceed the level of the adjacent fields and shall have adequate crossfall to achieve surface water run-off.
18. Upon completion, the tipped area shall be capped with a minimum 250mm thickness of compacted clay topped with a 250mm layer of subsoil and finished with a minimum 150mm thickness of topsoil cultivated and seeded to grass.



LAND ADJACENT TO THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF SEA VIEW FARM,
ASTON HILL, HAWARDEN

1. This licence shall enure for the benefit of the applicants only and shall expire after a period of five years from the date of issue.
2. Only inert non-toxic non-leachate producing wastes, rock, sand, builder's hardcore, subsoil, topsoil and similar excavated material shall be deposited on the site. No materials may be deposited in containers of any description.

NOTE:

Off-cuts of ferrous and non-ferrous metals, scrap timber, plastic and paper may be deposited when mixed with waste building and civil engineering materials, provided that the maximum amount tipped in any one load does not exceed 10% of the volume of the material in that one load.

3. No other materials may be deposited on the site without the prior written consent of the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
4. During prolonged periods of dry weather steps shall be taken to prevent any nuisance being caused from dust arising from the site including, where necessary, dampening down of the materials deposited.
5. - 10. A suitable sign shall be affixed to the entrance gate. The sign shall be weatherproof and comprise of red letters on a white background and shall read as follows:

- 11. Site operations shall be carried out between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive and 8.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Saturdays. No operations shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays without the prior approval of the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
- 12. The applicant shall be responsible for ensuring that all vehicles leaving the site do not carry mud or other debris onto the public highway and shall be responsible for the immediate removal of any such material which may be so deposited.
- 13. No tipping shall take place into water. The applicant shall be responsible for taking such steps as are considered necessary by the Alyn and Deeside District Council for the removal of any standing water prior to the commencement of the filling operation.
- 14. Prior to the commencement of the tipping operation, a plan shall be submitted for final approval to the Alyn and Deeside D.C. clearly indicating the method of operation.
- 15. The final level of the site shall not exceed the level of the adjacent fields and shall have adequate crossfall to achieve surface water run-off.
- 16. Upon completion, the tipped area shall be capped with a minimum 250mm thickness of compacted clay topped with a 250mm layer of subsoil and finished with a minimum 150mm thickness of topsoil cultivated and seeded to grass.
