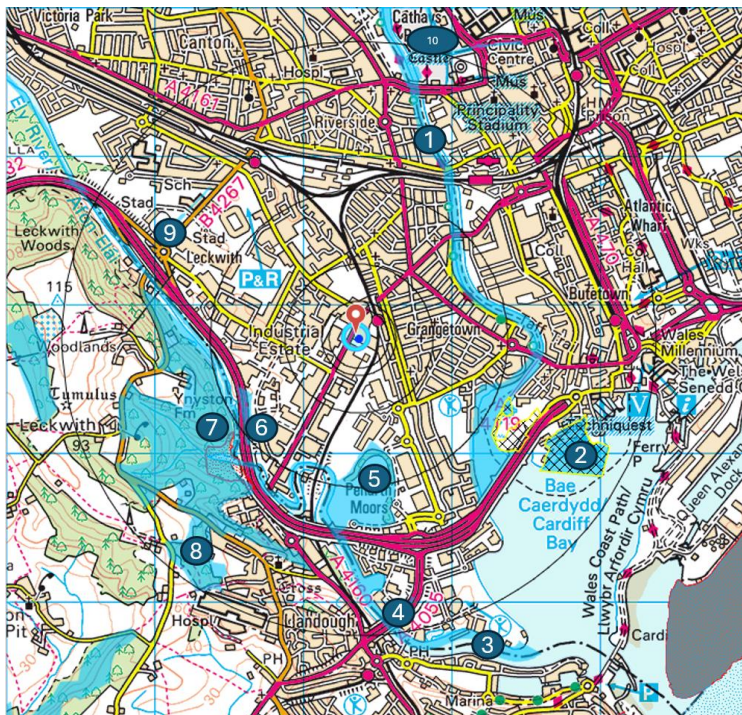

Appendix B CIRIA 736 Risk Assessment for Containment Classification

The supplied containment risk assessment is missing several aspects that are required for us to be able to Duly Make the application. Please could you ensure the following are supplied:

- Bund capacity calculations, in accordance with CIRIA C736, i.e. a bund capacity greater than 110% of the largest tank or 25% of the total tankage, whichever is the larger. We would expect to see all tanks to be located in the bunded area listed, with present storage volumes for each tank along with calculations for storage capacity of secondary containment also stated.
- Engineering design of structures in the containment system, if applicable. This could include technical specifications, construction CQA plans, detailed design or elevation drawings.
- Details of a procedure for managing and removing clean uncontaminated surface water collected within the bunded area(s) during normal operations.

Please reply within 10 working days from the date of this letter. If we don't hear from you we must return your application and fee. We will keep 14% of the charge to cover the cost of the assessment work done.

When we receive the missing items we'll continue to check the details in your application. If there's enough there for us to begin the process of deciding whether or not we can grant your application we say the application is 'duly made' and we'll let you know this by letter.
