### 3.31 Cable crossing and working agreements

3.31.1 The Licence Holder must submit Cable Crossing Agreements (CCA) with Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Ltd. and North Hoyle Offshore Windfarm Ltd. to the Licensing Authority at least 4 months prior to commencement of the Licensed Activities. No Licensed Activities may be undertaken prior to written approval from the Licensing Authority.

3.31.2 The Licence Holder must submit Simultaneous Operations (SIMOPS) Protocols with Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Ltd., Rhyl Flats Wind Farm Ltd., and North Hoyle Offshore Windfarm Ltd. to the Licensing Authority at least 4 months prior to commencement of the Licensed Activities. No Licensed Activities may be undertaken prior to written approval from the Licensing Authority.

3.31.3 The Licence Holder must ensure that any actions outlined in the documents detailed in condition 3.31.1 and 3.31.2 are implemented as approved in writing by the Licensing Authority. Any proposed changes to the actions outlined in the documents must be submitted to, and approved in writing by, the Licensing Authority prior to any changes being enacted.

We are pleased to submit the Cable Crossing Agreements recently signed with North Hoyle Offshore Windfarm Ltd and Gwynt Y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Ltd, respectively on 6 April and 16 April 2026.

- 1- Whilst completion of the agreements has been delayed by the Crossed Asset Owners, we have nevertheless been discharging our obligations under those agreements for several months now as though they were already fully executed. This has included:
  - Providing Design Information and method statements for the Crossed Asset Owners' review and approval. In all cases we can demonstrate such approvals.
  - Arranging for Crossed Asset Owners' to witness any works being carried out near their assets. Since space is limited on the vessels and there will be only limited opportunities to join and leave the vessels, this has been fulfilled by the provision of a shared Crossing Representative on each of the campaigns. The Crossing Representatives have been engaged by LBCCS, but their sole responsibilities are to represent each of the Crossed Asset Owners in turn. A Scope of Work has been drafted and includes Crossing Representatives' duties that has been reviewed by the Crossed Asset Owners to ensure that it is fit for purpose.
  - Notifying the Crossed Asset Owners as to any changes to programme, and keeping them informed of upcoming works.
- 2- The relevant agreements now being in place (with North Hoyle and GYM OWF), we will continue to discharge our obligations, to include:
  - Continuation of the measures above.
  - Provision of DPRs (Daily Progress Reports) during any work in the relevant notification areas.
  - Provision of in-survey and out-survey data demonstrating that the crossing has been constructed according to approved design and method.
  - Provision of as-built data following completion of relevant campaigns.
- 3- None of the Crossed Asset Owners, having been advised of LBCCS' installation plans and programme, have advised of any planned works requiring SIMOPs. We will continue to check that this is the case for subsequent campaigns.
- 4- It is not a situation that requires SIMOPs as such, but LBCCS' installers are in communication with the appropriate contacts at GYM OWF to ensure that any O&M vessels accessing their assets are aware of LBCCS' contractor's vessels and activities, and observe a suitable exclusion zone around vessels under limited manoeuvrability.
