We need more information about your application

Thank you for your application received on 27/12/2018.

We need to ask you for some more information before we can do any more work on it.
Please would you:

- In form B7 question 3 you stated that you will be treating the used sheep dip before it is discharged. Can you please confirm if this is correct, and if so, how you plan to do this?
- Confirm the type of sheep dip that is planned to be discharged as stated in form B7 Appendix 1 question 1. On the application form you have selected two different types of sheep dip which have different properties. We require the specific type of sheep dip in order to determine the chemical loading in our assessment.
- It appears you may have selected the incorrect regulated facility that you are applying for in form B2 question 2c. We believe that you require a permit for a water discharge activity (land spreading). Could you please confirm that this is correct?
- provide us with more information to question 3d[3] in form B2. We require you to submit a summary of your environment management system.
- Provide a non-technical summary of your application as stated in for B2 question 5c. We require you to write a summary that explains your application, in non-technical language as much as possible, avoiding technical terms, detailed data and scientific discussion.
