Good afternoon Daniel,

Thank you for your email, we would not consider that the works fall within the exemption 18 of maintenance of coastal defence structure. As previously advised it may be possible that the works fall within a band 1 application, however in order to consider beach management as a band 1 application you will need to provide evidence to demonstrate that the you are returning beach to its original profile. I would also note that a band 1 application can last for a maximum of 1 year. I would also remind you for band 1 application you will need to contact the maritime and coastguard agency (MCA), as well as confirmation from welsh archaeological trust (WAT) that impact to archaeological feature is not predicted, (should you provide us with further details regarding the works and confirm your intention to submit a band 1 licence we can send a preliminary email to WAT in order to seek advice.

If you are unable to demonstrate that you that you are returning the beach to its original profile, or you would like us to consider a longer term licence then a band 2 application would be required. For band 2 application we will consult with the MCA and WAT during the determination of the licence therefore you would not need to provide us with confirmation from the MCA or WAT with the application.

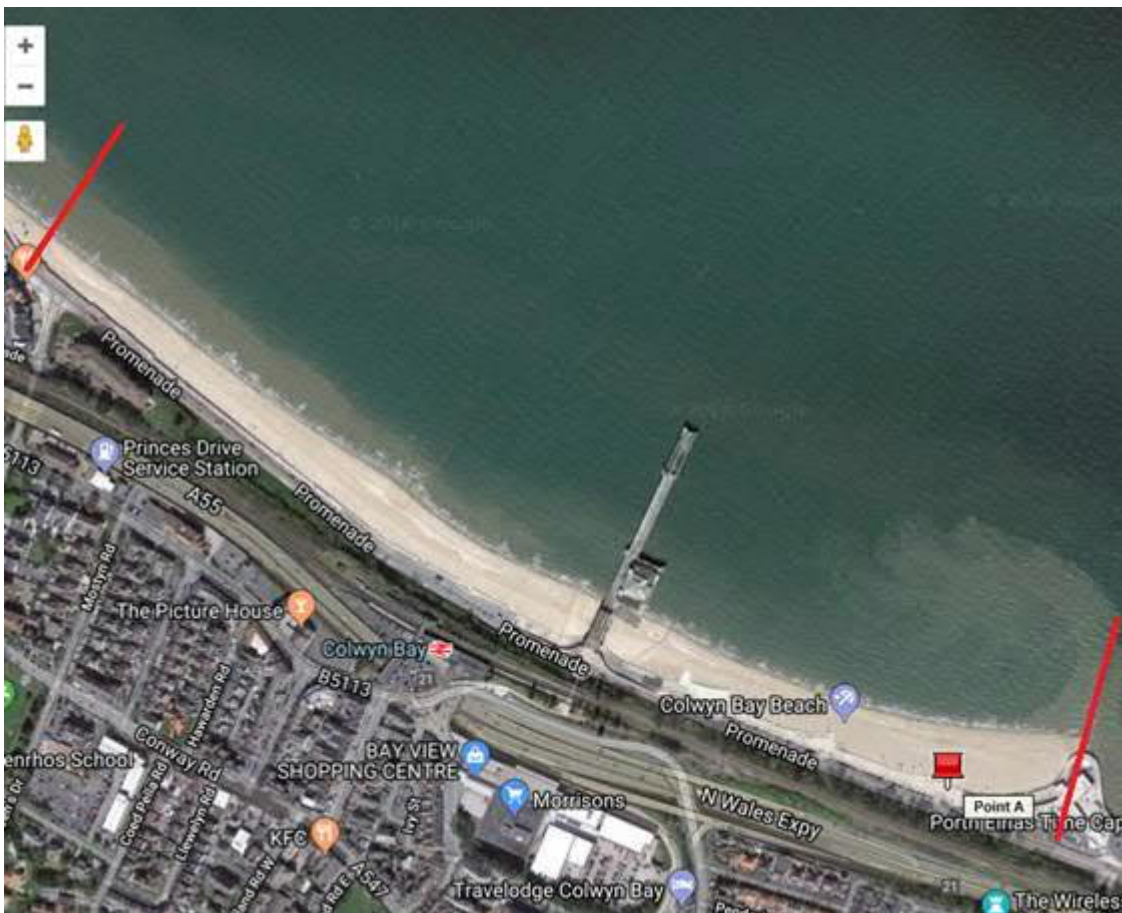
