Good Morning Gwyn,

For the purposes of your Band 1 (Low Risk Activity) Marine Licence application to Natural Resources Wales, I confirm that the MCA are content that on this occasion the risk to navigation safety remains low, provided that the following safety measures are put into place;

1. The Licencee must ensure that local mariners and fishermen's organisations are made fully aware of the activity through local notices to mariners.
2. The Licencee must ensure that HM Coastguard, in this case nmoccontroller@hmcg.gov.uk, The National Maritime Operations Centre is made aware of the works prior to commencement.
3. The Consent Holder should ensure suitable bunding, storage facilities are employed to prevent the release of fuel oils, lubricating fluids associated with the plant and equipment into the marine environment.

Again I have cc'd in NRW so they are aware of our response.

I am presently applying for a Band 1 Marine Licence to undertake some re-profiling of the sand on the foreshore at Colwyn Bay, North Wales.

As part of the pre-application process NRW have informed that there is a requirement to consult with the Marine and Coastguard Agency to seek comments on the effect of our proposed works.

Please find attached a location plan showing the extent of the sand re-profiling. The works entail the use of a bulldozer, excavator and dumper to re-profile the beach to its original design profile.

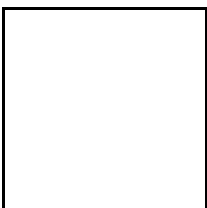
Our Coastal Term Contractor will provide Method Statements and Risk Assessments for the works, which will include suitable fencing / signing as required for safe execution of the task.
