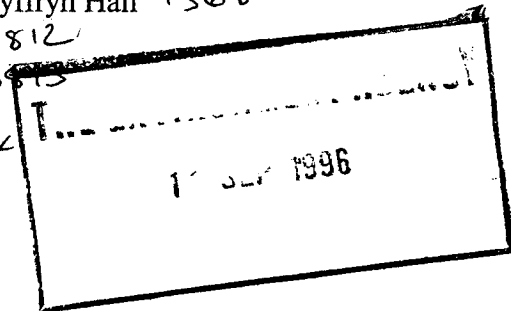

to pre-1951 discharge of trade or sewage effluent to a stream.

TO:—

DEE AND CLWYD RIVER AUTHORITY,

The Dee and Clwyd River Authority, pursuant to Section 1 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1961, HEREBY GRANT CONSENT to the discharge of purified domestic sewage effluent from Graianhyd County Primary School into an unnamed tributary of the River Lorrig being a stream in the Dee and Clwyd River Authority Area in accordance with your application dated the 5th December, 1963, SUBJECT to the following conditions:—

1. The effluent discharged shall have a Biochemical Oxygen Demand in 5 days at 20°C of not more than 50 milligrams per litre.
2. The volume of effluent discharged shall not exceed 1.15 cubic metres (255 gallons) in any period of twenty-four hours.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 1(2) of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1961, the agreed sampling point shall be the outlet pipe to the stream at U.S.G. 2175 5615.

The terms of this Consent will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this Consent is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the 31st day of December, 1969.
