

NON TECHNICA SUMMARY (NTS) Version 2.0 April 2026

MINOR TECHNICAL VARIATION (**max 15 additional EWC code request**)

DETAILS OF THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO VARY PERMIT EPR/NB3339RH

To add additional EWC codes to the existing bespoke permit to include:

13 01 (130110 and 130113)

13 02 (130205 and 130208)

13 03 (130307 and 130308)

13 04 (130403)

13 05 (130501, 130502, 130503, 130506 and 130508)

13 07 (130701)

13 08 (130801 and 130802).

Including the existing EWC codes already permitted to be accepted under permit EPR/NB3339RH the amount of hazardous waste accepted on site per day will not exceed 10 tonnes and the total quantity of hazardous waste stored on site at any one time will not exceed 50 tonnes. Not more than 50 tonnes per day will be accepted of non-recyclable non-hazardous wastes. No more than 10 tonnes of the proposed new codes accepted on site per day and no more than 20 tonnes of proposed new codes stored on site at any one time.

These waste loads will be bulked up on site for onward transport reasons. Bulking up will only take place within the bunded hazardous store or in the external bunded hazardous waste compound. There will be no mixing of different waste codes and hazardous waste will not be mixed with non-hazardous wastes. Each waste type will be stored separately.

No treatment will be carried out on the requested additional EWC codes.

Waste will only be accepted in UN approved containers (IBCs and drums/containers), not transferred from tankers to IBC.

These liquid wastes listed above will be securely stored within the site inside the bunded hazardous waste building or externally within the bunded hazardous waste compound. They will also be stored as recommended by the Fire Prevention & Management Guidance. The EMP and FPMP will be updated accordingly.
