Further to your application the Agency has decided that consent should be given subject to conditions. I enclose the Agency's formal consent to discharge biologically treated sewage and trade effluent from Porthmadog Holiday Camp Ltd.

Under the present Scheme of Charges for Discharges to Controlled Waters an annual charge will be made for all consents to discharge, except where the discharge is of sewage effluent of five cubic metres or less per day. The charge is based on information derived from the conditions attached to the consent to discharge, as outlined in the enclosed leaflet.

If you consider that the conditions imposed by the consent are unreasonable you have a right of appeal to the National Assembly for Wales at Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ.

Notice of an appeal must be given in writing within three months of this notification and must be accompanied by a statement of the grounds of appeal.

If granted, a consent under Schedule 10 of the Act, covers water quality considerations only. It does not alter the need to obtain any other consents or approvals which might be required in connection with your proposal under other legislation. For example it does not give any right or permission to discharge where land is not owned by the applicant.

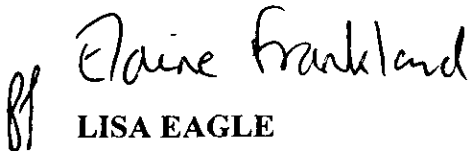

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

Biologically-treated Sewage and Trade Effluent ("the Discharge")

FROM: Porthmadog Holiday Camp Limited, Aberdunant Caravan Park, Prenteg, near Porthmadog, Gwynedd LL49 9SR

1. (a) The Discharge shall not contain any poisonous, noxious or polluting matter or solid waste matter.
- (b) Provided that the Discharge hereby consented is made in accordance with the following conditions of this consent, such discharge shall not be taken to be in breach of condition (a) above by reason of containing substances or having properties identified in and controlled by these conditions.

NATURE

2. The Discharge shall consist solely of biologically-treated sewage and trade effluent arising from Porthmadog Holiday Camp Limited, Aberdunant Caravan Park, Prenteg, near Porthmadog.

LOCATION

3. The Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
 - (a) discharging via a 100 millimetre diameter pipe;
 - (b) discharging to the Afon Gwenyn;
 - (c) at National Grid Reference SH 58675 41853;
 - (d) shown marked 'Discharge Point' on Plan CG0392801 attached as Annex 1.

SAMPLE POINT

4. An appropriately labelled sample point shall be provided and maintained at National Grid Reference SH 58670 41855, as shown marked 'Sampling Point' on Plan G0392801, so that a representative sample of the Discharge may be obtained. The Consent Holder shall ensure that all constituents of the Discharge pass through the said sampling point at all times and in any legal proceedings it shall, for the purposes of Section 10 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1961, be presumed, until the contrary is shown that any sample of the Discharge taken at the said sampling point is a sample of what was discharging into controlled waters.

VOLUME

5. (a) From the 1st of March up to and including the 31st October the volume of the Discharge shall not exceed 15 cubic metres per day.
- (b) From the 1st November up to and including the 28th February (or 29th in a leap year) the volume of the discharge shall not exceed 5 cubic metres per day.

FLOW MEASUREMENT

6. At the request of the Agency, the Consent Holder shall install, operate and maintain a means of flow measuring to a specification and at a location required by the Agency, to enable the daily volume and/or instantaneous flow of the discharge through the treatment works to be recorded. The Consent Holder shall calibrate, operate and maintain the flow recorder to a standard agreed or specified by the Agency. The flow and maintenance records shall be provided to the Agency as and when requested.

COMPOSITION

7. The Discharge shall not contain more than:
 - (i) 40 milligrammes per litre of biochemical oxygen demand (measured after 5 days at 20 °C with nitrification suppressed by the addition of allyl thiourea);
 - (ii) 60 milligrammes per litre of suspended solids (measured after drying at 105 °C).

MAINTENANCE

8. As far as is reasonably practicable, the treatment plant shall be operated so as to prevent:
 - (a) any matter being present in the Discharge, other than matter specifically covered by numerical conditions in this consent, to such an extent as to cause the receiving waters, or any waters of which the receiving waters are a tributary, to be poisonous or injurious to fish in those waters, or to the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish in those waters, or otherwise cause damage to the ecology of those waters; and the Discharge from having any other adverse environmental impact.
9. The Discharge shall not cause any adverse effects on sources of water used for public or private potable supply.
