Schedule

Action: Provide evidence and/or an agreement between VDC CWL12 Limited and Vantage Data Centers UK Limited to prevent cell testing of both CWL11 and CWL12 occurring between the two sites at the same time.

Reason: At present the Permit EPR/BB3599CW/V004, specifies that if engines in a cell are started/run up for testing purposes, there is to be no overlapping testing with other cells. We need to ensure that the conditions, operating techniques and management systems of the two permits after the variation will have the same environmental impact as the original permit. As such we need evidence of co-ordination between the two permit holders to prevent testing of the cells of both CWL11 and CWL12 occurring at the same time.
