Under Section 41(6) of the Environment Act 1995 **Natural Resources Wales** may suspend an environmental licence to the extent that it authorises the carrying on of an authorised activity if the subsistence fees which are due and payable for the environmental licence have not been paid.

Your subsistence fees for the period (i) 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019, (ii) 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020, (iii) 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021 and (iv) 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022; (v) 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023 are due and payable and have not been paid and so **Natural Resources Wales** has decided to suspend the environmental licence EPR/GP3191SA to the extent that it authorises the activities set out in Schedule 1 of this notice.

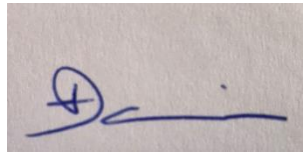
You remain bound by the remaining conditions of the environmental licence listed in Schedule 2 of this notice.

The suspension remains in force until **Natural Resources Wales** receives full payment of the sum £9,765.00 , for the above periods, and notifies you in writing.

Notes:

General

1. During the period of suspension your environmental licence does not authorise you to carry on the suspended activities.
2. Carrying on the suspended activities during the period of suspension is an offence and legal action may be taken against you.
3. You remain bound by the conditions of your environmental licence set out in schedule 2.
4. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Appeal provisions

There is no appeal mechanism available in the legislation against the service of this Notice.

Legislation note

In this document “Natural Resources Wales” means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.
