Cryddan Brook Flood Alleviation Scheme

Please provide a brief description of the proposed project, including location

The Applicant (Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council) is seeking planning permission to address the flood risk caused by Cryddan Brook, Melyn, Neath in South Wales through a new flood alleviation scheme, which would increase capacity within the existing river network to deal with frequent flooding and provide a better level of protection. There have been historical issues with blockages at the existing St Catherine's Close Culvert and overflow debris screens, which has led to the backing up of water in the watercourse. The water has previously overtopped the existing walls and flowed towards properties along St Catherine's Close and flowed north-westward to flood the A474 Briton Ferry Road. The culverts in the existing watercourse at St Catherine's Close, the railway crossing and in Milland Road Industrial Estate also have insufficient capacity to deal with frequent flood events.
