Swansea Inner West Pier Marine Works - Marine Licence application CML1858

Thank you for providing the advice from Cefas on the proposed dredge and disposal that is required as part of the above works.

I can confirm that the category of debris located at the application site is man-made (e.g. shopping trolleys, masonry, paint cans etc.). Any man-made debris collected as part of the bed preparation works will be separated from the dredged material and disposed of at a suitable landfill site.

Based on a visual inspection on site during the walk-over survey, the volume of boulders across the area to be dredged is less than circa 50m³. The boulders are relatively small, ranging in size from approximately 25-30 cm.

We will provide further details of the proposed dredging and disposal contractor and vessels once this is known and in advance of the works.
