ORDER

UPON THE PETITION of Alec Sellem, Jamie Afnaim and Rachael Reid, in their capacity as of directors of Unimetals Recycling (UK) Limited, of Long Marston, Stratford-Upon-Avon, Warwickshire, United Kingdom, CV37 8AQ, the petition having been presented to this Court on 24 November 2025 seeking an immediate winding up order and direction that the hearing be heard on an urgent and out of hours basis for the reasons set out in the first and second witness statements of Rachael Reid dated 23 November 2025 and 24 November 2025 respectively (the 'Petition')

AND UPON HEARING Ms Katie Longstaff, Counsel for the Petitioners

AND UPON THE COURT HAVING READ the witness statement of Fiona Siddall dated 23 November 2025, the first witness statement of Rachael Reid dated 23 November 2025 and the second witness statement of Rachael Reid dated 24 November 2025

AND UPON THE COURT BEING SATISFIED that these proceedings are COMI proceedings for the purposes of the EU Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings as it has effect in the law of the United Kingdom

AND UPON THE COURT BEING SATISFIED that the case is urgent and listing the Petition to be heard on an urgent basis, out of hours, for the reasons provided for in the evidence

AND UPON THE COURT BEING SATISFIED that the case is urgent and an immediate winding up order should be made

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The requirement to serve the Petition on Unimetals Recycling (UK) Limited in accordance with rule 7.9(1) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 ('IR16') is dispensed with pursuant to CPR 3.1(2)(p) and r.12.1(1) IR16.
- (2) The requirement to give notice of the Petition in accordance with rule 7.10(1) IR16 is dispensed pursuant to that provision.
- (3) The requirement to file a certificate of compliance as required by rule 7.12 IR16 is therefore dispensed with pursuant to CPR 3.1(2)(p) and r.12.1(1) IR16.
- (4) Unimetals Recycling (UK) Limited is hereby wound up under the Insolvency Act 1986 ('IA86') with immediate effect, with the Official Receiver being automatically appointed as liquidator in accordance with section 136 IA86.
- (5) The Petitioners' costs be an expense of the liquidation.
