## RURAL DISTRICT OF TWRCELYN

### REGULATIONS

*made by the*

RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL OF TWRCELYN.

*With respect to the user of the foreshore situate within or adjacent to the Rural District of Twrceilyn, in the Parishes of Llanfairynghorwry, Llanbadrig, Llanelidan, Penrhoslligwy, Llanallgo, Llanaugrad and Llanfair Mathafarn Eithaf.*

THESE REGULATIONS are made in virtue of the proprietary rights of the said Council in the Foreshore between high and low water mark of ordinary tides such rights being exercisable by the said Council under a Crown Lease granted to the said Council by the Minister of Transport on the 31st day of December 1949, and these regulations shall remain operative, as regards the said foreshore, only so long as the said Foreshore continues to be held under the said Crown Lease.

1. No person shall, without previously having obtained from the Council a licence to use the said Foreshore, and subject to the conditions specified in such licence (which licence shall be valid only for the period mentioned therein) :

(a) sell or hawk, or offer or expose for sale on any part of the Foreshore any article, commodity or thing,



- (b) erect or place on any part of the Foreshore any booth, tent, shed, stalls (whether fixed or moveable) show, swing, exhibition, roundabout, bathing machine, apparatus or other structure or erection, or park or drive on the said Foreshore any cart, bicycle, motor vehicle or any other vehicle,
  - (c) show or exhibit any trade, business, or handicraft, performance or calling, or any advertising board or placard on any part of the Foreshore,
  - (d) with a view to gaining or receiving profit or reward, play any musical instrument or sing, or conduct any entertainment on any part of the Foreshore,
  - (e) let or expose for hire on any part of the Foreshore any chair, seat, form, stand, platform or other thing,
  - (f) offer or expose for letting to hire on any part of the Foreshore any donkey, pony, horse, or other beast of burden or draught, any bicycle, tricycle, or other vehicle, or
  - (g) take for reward or profit any photograph on any part of the Foreshore,
  - (h) offer or expose for letting to hire on any part of the Foreshore any rowing boat, motor boat, yacht or raft.
2. A Licence to use the Foreshore shall be subject to such conditions and remain valid for such period as shall be specified thereon.
3. The fees for a week or for a season payable upon the issue of the Licences above mentioned shall be such as may from time to time be prescribed by the Council.

4. In the event of the number of applications for Licences exceeding the number of Licences which the Council may from time to time decide to issue for any of the purposes mentioned in Clause one, the Council in such case shall have the right of offering such Licences by public auction, or of inviting tenders for the same by advertisement in the local newspapers, and of accepting any offers in excess of the charges above mentioned. The Council however in cases where they adopt this procedure shall not be bound to accept the highest or any offer or bid which may be made for any particular privilege.

5. The expression "season" means the months of May, June, July, August, September, and October.

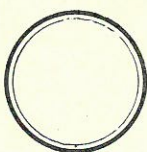
