# 1 List of Waste codes

## 1.1 List of waste codes

The company does not propose to change any of the waste codes currently authorised by the site’s environmental permit. Question 1 of application form Parts B3 and B4 requires that a list of wastes be proposed for each activity that is to be carried out.

Table 1 lists the wastes that are currently acceptable at the facility which will be handled by the scheduled metal shredder installation.

The same list of wastes will also be accepted as part of activity 1, the metal recycling waste operation.

**Table 1: List of wastes to be accepted as part of the metal shredder installation**
