ENVIRONMENTAL PERMIT BP0284501 – PERMIT CONDITION EXCEEDANCE

I append a table (see overleaf) of results following analysis of a sample of the discharge from the sewage works at the ATEB Residential Development at Stepside that we took on 25 October 2019. This sample was tested and found to be in exceedance of the consented discharge for this site. Having not met the permit limits, the sample shows that the effluent was poorly treated.

In our previous correspondence on this matter (dated 08 February 2019) we indicated that a permit breach following that date would be taken in a formal manner and may be used in as part of enforcement action.

Our records show that over the past two years your site has breached the discharge limits set out in your permit at least four times.

I wish to arrange an onsite meeting with yourself to discuss;

- the circumstances which have led to these permit exceedances; and
- the action that will be taken to control the risk of further breaches occurring.

I am available on 1000, 21 November 2019 and wish to meet you at this time at the permitted site. From the discussion at this meeting we will consider on how to proceed with this matter.
